

Finding the right fit





AT is...

...any device, no matter where or how you get it, that is used to increase, maintain, or improve the functional capabilities of people with disabilities



...any service that helps with selecting, acquiring, or using an assistive technology device.

Barriers

- Don't want to be seen as old or incapable
- Don't want to be a burden
- Don't want my doctor to think I am struggling
- Don't want my kids to think I am struggling
- ▶ I am the caregiver for my spouse, my needs don't matter
- ▶ I don't want to accept my changing limitations
- "I'm not that bad yet"

Staying "Good"

- Just like our cars and computers, we benefit from a diagnostic check up and updates.
- Because we cannot be plugged in for these tests, we have to do them ourselves or with professionals.
- Ignoring a problem rarely makes it go away.
- And, much like home repairs, the sooner we address a problem, the easier (and cheaper) it is to tackle it.



Personal Care - Dressing

 button aids, long handled shoe horns, sock aids, visual aids, adapted clothing, magnetic "buttons", no tie shoe laces

Personal Care - Bathing

shower chairs and benches, hand held showers, soap dispensers, long handled brushes, one handed towels, grab bars

Personal Care - Toileting

▶ **Toileting**-bidets!, toilet safety frame, grab bars, 3/1 commode, stool riser

Toilet Safety Frame \$50-\$100




Meals - Prep








Home Modifications - smaller
